COVID-19 OUTDOOR VISITATION GUIDANCE

OHIO DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH (ODH) GUIDANCE

Recognizing the effects of isolation on the health and well-being of residents in long-term care settings, the Ohio Department of Health has issued guidance to allow for outdoor visitation.

The guidance is designed to reduce transmission and prevent outbreaks of COVID-19 in long-term care settings. The risk of virus transmission in our community and the need for meaningful connections with loved ones can be balanced under the following conditions:

PROVIDER CRITERIA

- Establish a schedule for visitation hours. Work with prospective visitors individually.
- Ensure adequate staffare present to help with outdoor transition of residents and wipe down any visitation areas as necessary.
- Maintain visual observation of visit but provide as much distance as necessary to allow for privacy.
- Screen visitors for signs and symptoms of COVID-19 at a location outside the building.
- Ensure residents and visitors wear a mask or other face covering at all times,
- Ensure outdoor visitation space is accessible without visitors having to walk through the building.
- Ensure appropriate social distancing of at least 6 feet between the visitor and resident.
- Provide alcohol-based hand rub to visitors and provide signage or verbal reminders of correct use.
- Establish additional guidelines as needed to ensure the safety of visitations, setting operations and individual needs of residents.

Homes retain the right to deny an outdoor visit if the resident or visitor does not comply with infection control guidance or if certain setting and community conditions exist

RESIDENT CRITERIA

- Current COVID-19 positive residents are not eligible for outside visits.
- Residents with current COVID-19 signs or symptoms are not eligible for outside visits.
- Residents in a 14-day quarantine or observation are not eligible for outside visits.
- Residents should wear a mask, or other face covering, where possible, for the entire visit.
- Residents are encouraged to have a contactfree visit.



Weather Consideration: Visits should occur on days when there is no weather

VISITOR CRITERIA

- Must wear a mask or other facial covering during entire visit unless medically contraindicated.
- Must be screened for symptoms of COVID-19 and attest to their COVID status if known.
- Must use alcohol-based hand rub upon entering an exiting the visitation area.
- . Should not walk through building to get to outdoor visitation space.
- Must sign in and provide contact information.
- Must maintain 6 feet social distance.
- No physical contact (holding hands, hugs, kissing) is allowed.
- Must stay in designated locations at setting.
- All visitors shall be over the age of two and must comply with screening and social distancing requirements.
- Pets must be under control of the visitors.
