

PHASED APPROACH TO VISITATION RE-OPENING



Current Status: Phase 2

(Move to next phase contingent on guidance from ODH; setting may revert to prior phase pending COVID-19 status in setting.)

ALLOWED

- **Essential health care personnel and compassionate care visits for end-of life** that comply with screening upon entry and take additional infection control precautions (ie: social distancing, hand hygiene). All health care personnel and visitors must wear a face mask for the duration of the visit, and limit movement within the setting.
- **Virtual visits**
- **Window visits** coordinated at the discretion of setting in consideration of social distance and universal source control.

Visits from previous phase plus:

- **Outdoor visits** conducted at discretion of the setting based on guidance from ODH. Outdoor visits should be limited to residents who are COVID-19 negative and have no signs or symptoms of the virus. Providers should establish visitation hours screening requirements, and schedule visits in advance. Residents and visitors must comply with screening protocols, social distancing and universal source control.

Visits from previous phases plus:

- **Limited in-person visits** conducted at discretion of the setting based on CDC, CMS and ODH guidance for all residents who are COVID-19 negative that comply with the setting visitation and screening policies.

(Potential Examples Based on CDC: Current COVID-19 status in building and in broader community; testing status; screening procedures; infection control practices, universal source control and other use of PPE; staffing; established visiting hours.)

NOT ALLOWED

- In-person visits (other than essential health care personnel and compassionate care for end-of-life).
- Outdoor visits.

- In-person visits (other than essential health care personnel and compassionate care for end-of-life).

- **Unscheduled in-person visits** or visits that do not comply with the setting's visitation policy.
