### The Campaign Continues: Act For Older Adults

Congress is back in DC and negotiations on the next COVID-19 relief package have already begun. That means we need to ramp our collective advocacy efforts more than ever.

Last night, our president and CEO, <u>Katie Smith Sloan told NBC Nightly News</u> that aging services providers are getting hit by COVID-19 like a category-5 hurricane. The national news story was an outcome of coverage driven by our national-local press conference Monday and is part of our urgent effort to break-through with our messages right now, as Congress works on the next COVID-19 relief legislation.

Starting tomorrow, look for a new series of social media posts, asking you and all of our social media networks to take an action to show your support for aging services providers and older adults. Every day, we'll post another way to get involved–from taking an #Act4OlderAdults Mask Selfie (<u>download your printable mask template here</u>) to sending an email to your representatives.
