<input type="checkbox"/> March 22, 2023	<p>Part 3: Speech-Language Pathology <i>Julie Bellucci, MS CCC-SLP, Premier Therapy; Susan Wallace, LeadingAge Ohio</i></p> <p>The speech language pathology is one complex component of PDPM containing elements which could be misinterpreted and lead to issues with coding, denials, and inaccurate care planning. This webinar will cover coding elements used to qualify for the speech component, coding scenarios, and keys to improve collaboration between dietary and speech therapy. Helpful tips will be shared to improve understanding of terminology, facilitate increased collaboration, and improve MDS accuracy/outcomes for the resident.</p>
