<input type="checkbox"/> October 11, 2023	Significant Change in Status <i>Significant change citations are prevalent in five of the top ten F-tag citations in Ohio in 2023. This session will cover how a significant change in status results in citations. The surveyor protocol in determining if a significant change is avoidable or unavoidable will be explained. Regulatory language and recommended standards of practice will be shared. ODH updates and current citation trends in Ohio will be discussed.</i>
<input type="checkbox"/> November 8, 2023	Accidents and Hazards <i>F-tag 689 Accidents and Hazards is the top cited F-tag for complaint surveys in Ohio. It is the third most frequently cited F-tag for annual surveys. This session will cover the surveyor guidance on determining how an accident results in noncompliance. Regulatory language and recommended standards of practice will be shared. ODH updates and current citation trends in Ohio will be discussed.</i>
<input type="checkbox"/> December 13, 2023	Infection Prevention and Control Program <i>F-tag 880 Infection Control is the fifth most frequently cited F-tag in 2023 for annual surveys in Ohio. This session will include a review of the trends in infection prevention and control citations. Regulatory language and recommended standards of practice will be shared. ODH updates and current citation trends in Ohio will be discussed.</i>
